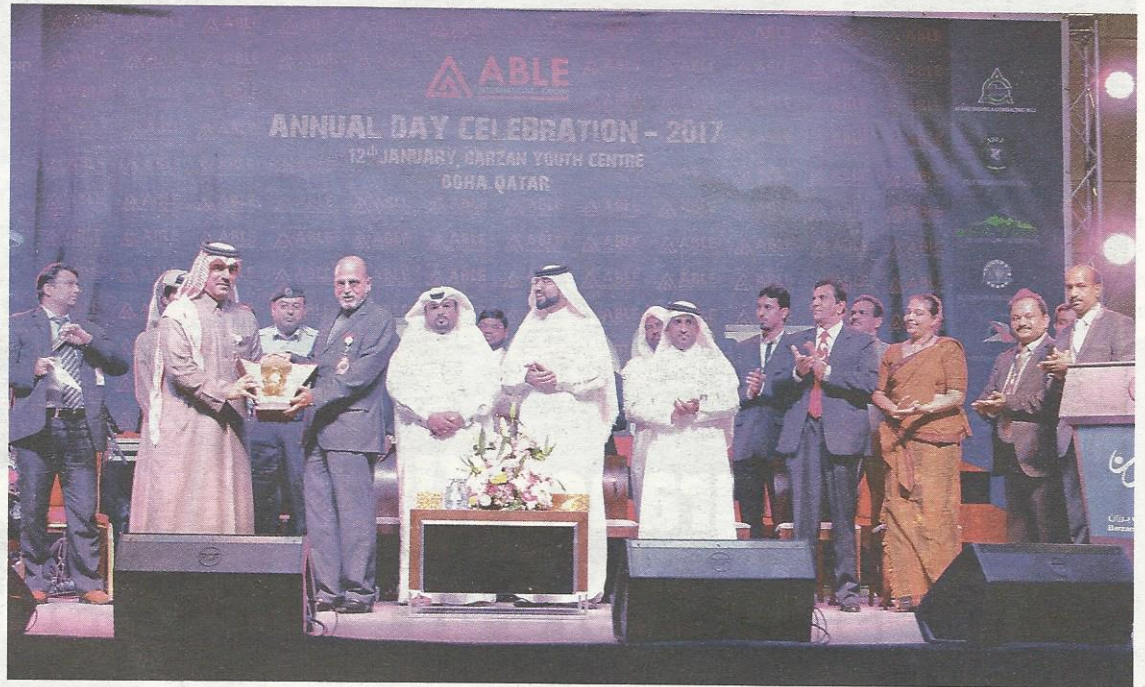


AROSE celebrates annual day
