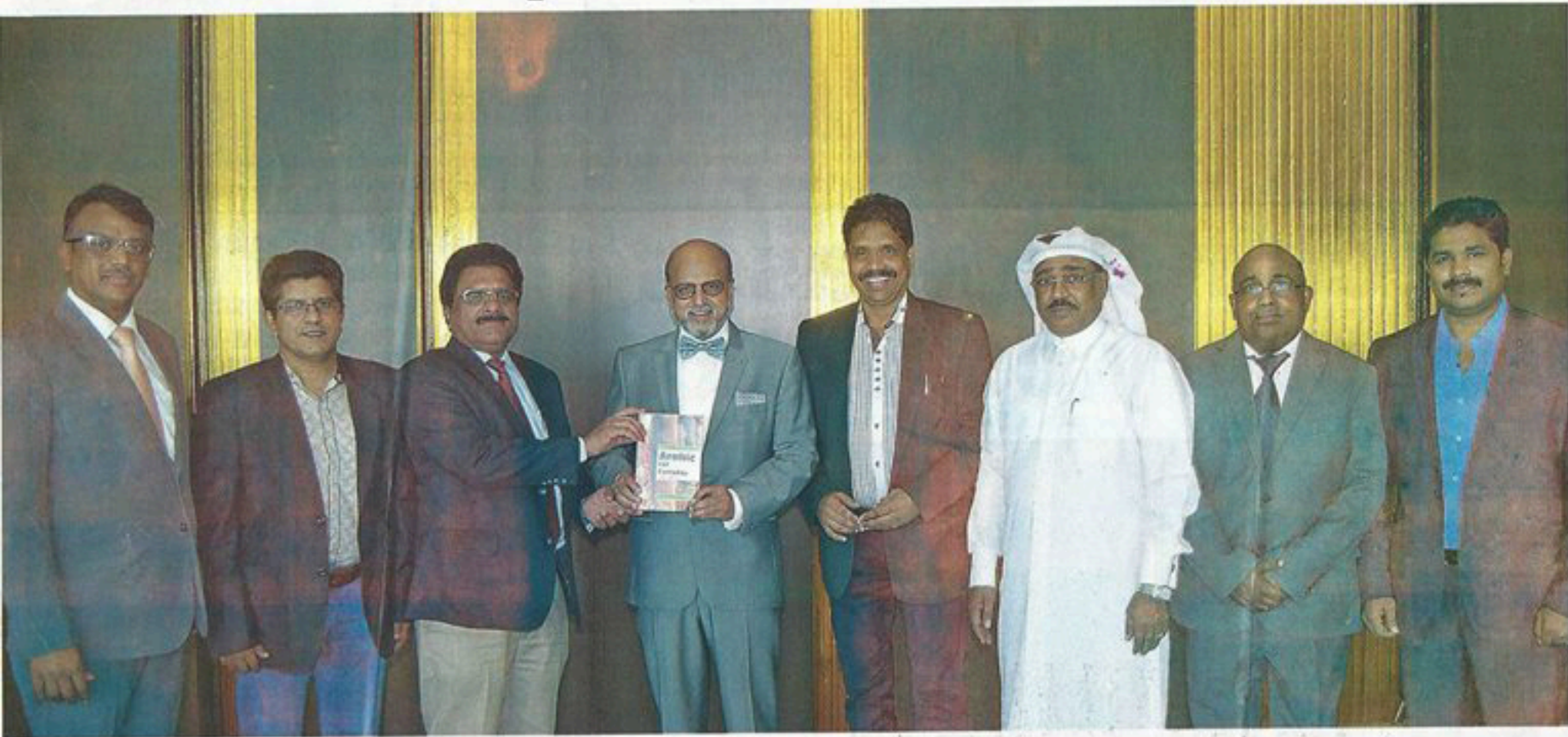


Book on spoken Arabic released
